12:00 pm - 12:50 pm EST > Unmanned Systems, Conflict, and Terrorism by John Sullivan, Ret. Lieutenant, LASD - Explore how drones and other unmanned systems are changing the battlefield. From surveillance to weaponization, these technologies are altering terrorist tactics and military operations, raising urgent ethical and strategic questions.
